With AKSHAM, the Albanian-born singer Elina Duni, pianist Marc Perrenoud from Geneva, and French trumpeter David Enhco enter into an extraordinary alliance: Their fragile music interweaves Duni's touching singing and Perrenoud's subtle keyboard skills with Enhco's lyrical trumpet sounds and the agile, airy rhythmic patterns of Florent Nisse on the double bass and Fred Pasqua on drums. The quintet captures distant melodies, overcomes geographical boundaries, and explores new musical territories. In their repertoire, sung in French and English, AKSHAM sensitively incorporates poetic and musical sources of inspiration and creates their own inspiring world of sound. AKSHAM is a five-part storyteller who sends shivers down your spine.
